I have returned from Region with lots to tell you about.

First, the 2010 WSC.

Jamie and Amanda (our RD and RD-Alt) returned with LOTS of information to share after their week at WSC. So much so that they passed out CDs containing all the notes, presentations and minutes that they brought back. I am going to do the same. I have made 10 copies of these CDs to pass on to whomever wants them. I highly recommend going through them at your leisure. A couple of highlights:

4) It was decided that a Traditions Working Guide would be developed.

5) The 2009 Membership Survey results will soon be available on the NA website.

6) There are currently around 600,000 members of NA. Over 300,000 of them are in Iran.

Now for Regional;

First, for those of you who know Jonna, she was unable to make it due to serious illness. I haven't received any current statuses, so please pray for her.

Committee budgets were presented and voted on. The PI committee was able to lower their budget by \$1000 dollars because they decided to quit printing/distributing Iowa Regional meeting lists. They will still be available on the website. This was decided because by the time each one was printed, it was already wrong. The RCM (me) will be responsible for communication to the Iowa Web servant for changes.

It was brought up that the 30th Anniversary Celebration of the Iowa Region was going to fall in June of 2011, which is when Region would be held in SWINA. There was much discussion about if the celebration should be held in conjunction with region or as a separate event. Then it was discovered

that the first Regional meeting was held in October, not June. It was decided that the celebration will be held then also. More will be revealed.

It was also voted that the IRCNA Standing committee would get and be responsible for their own tax ID number. They have been using the Regional number up till now and it has caused some confusion. The Vice-Chair for the Region, Peter B., has resigned. Since Elections will be coming up soon, it was agreed to just do without a vice-chair until then.

It was voted that \$806 will be donated to World.

One more thing; World Services will be holding several workshops on better communication in the near future for RDs. We are to bring it back to the area to ask if we want to fund our RDs to these workshops so that they can in turn bring the information back and hold workshops for us. I am of the opinion that this is exactly the kind of thing we have RDs for and therefore should allow it. The next Regional will be the 3rd weekend of August and will be held in Dubuque and will be 2 days. Being as this is over 6 hours away, and 2 days, we will be requesting gas and hotel. I am turning in a receipt for \$25.17 to cover part of the gas for this regional.

On a personal note, I would like to thank Mike VP and Brandon S. for the fellowship on the ride and the company as we scooped down copious amounts of Blue Bunny ice cream before leaving town. Mmm mmm Good!

There seems to be a lot of interesting things happening in Lit for addict participation. A 12 Traditions Working Guide has passed at the World level and the project will start being assembled. Most of the request for this project came from Regions outside of the US.

The NA Way Magazine subscriptions will need to be updated because they are revising their database, cost of the subscriptions will be \$1.00 per group.

The Literature requested a \$300.00 budget for the year, and that passed.
